Project Overview:

The Houston Community College System ("HCC") is seeking proposals from qualified firms to provide Database Development and Management Services on an "as needed" basis.

Contract Approval: This procurement is subject to approval by HCC Board of Trustees. Subsequent to Board approval, the only person authorized to commit HCC contractually is the Chancellor or his designee.

Proposal Due Date/Time: HCC will accept proposals to provide the required Database Development & Management Services until 10:00 a.m. (local time) on Wednesday, September 27, 2006. Proposals will be received in Procurement Operations, 3100 South Main Street (11th Floor), Room 11A06, Houston, Texas 77002.

Contract Term: The contract term for contract(s) awarded resulting from this solicitation will be one (1) year with renewal options of two (2) one-year time periods.

HCC is an equal opportunity/educational institution, which does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, gender, age or disability.

HCC reserves the right to accept or reject all or any part of any proposal, waive any technicalities or irregularities in the proposal documents and consider the proposal for award.

This Request for Proposal does not obligate HCC to award a contract or to pay any costs incurred by a proposer in the preparation or submission of a proposal.

INSTRUCTIONS TO PROPOSERS

1. **Introduction**

HCC is seeking proposals under the negotiated method of procurement from qualified firms interested in providing services in accordance with the Scope of Services contained in this solicitation (Attachment No. 2).

2. Proposal Submittal

Proposer(s) shall submit one (1) original and <u>6 copies</u> of the technical proposal to the address shown below by the date and time specified in this solicitation. In addition to the technical and price proposal, each proposer must complete and return the following documents, if appropriate:

3. Eligibility for Award

- a. In order for a proposer to be eligible to be awarded the contract, the proposal must be responsive to the solicitation and HCC must be able to determine that the proposer is responsible and has the resources and capacity to perform the resulting contract satisfactorily.
- b. Responsive proposals are those complying in all material aspects of the solicitation. Proposals, which do not comply with all the terms and, conditions of this solicitation will be rejected as non-responsive.

- c. Responsible proposers as a minimum must:
 - Have adequate financial resources, or the ability to obtain such resources as required during the performance of the contract.
 - Be able to comply with the required performance schedule, taking into consideration all existing business commitments.
 - Have a satisfactory record of past performance.
 - Have necessary personnel and management capability to perform the contract.
 - Be qualified as an established firm regularly engaged in the type of business necessary to fulfill the contract requirements.
 - Certify that the firm is not delinquent in any tax owed the State of Texas under Chapter 171, Tax Code; signing and submitting the proposal is so certifying.
 - Be otherwise qualified and eligible to receive an award under applicable laws and regulations.

Proposer(s) may be requested to submit additional written evidence verifying that the firm meets the minimum criteria necessary to perform the requirements of the solicitation and be determined a responsible proposer. Failure to provide any requested additional information may result in the proposer being declared non-responsive, and the proposal being rejected.

4. Preparation of Proposal

Technical and Price Proposal:

The technical proposal shall include, as a minimum, the following information:

- <u>Cover letter</u>: The cover letter shall not exceed three (3) pages in length, summarizing key points in the proposal.
- **Project Understanding and Services:** This section shall include the firm's management and technical approach to the scope of services as well as a description of other services that the proposer can provide. This section shall also include:
 - 1. A management plan with defined lines of authority and proposer's commitment to utilize HCC students in an internship capacity with the firm.
 - 2. A description of other services and innovative solutions/strategies offered as part of proposal, in particular, technology-based solutions that provide cost/time savings.
 - 3. A description of the firm's capability (systems) to communicate with its clients. (i.e. E-Mail, Website, FAX, Telephone, etc.).
 - 4. A list of the type and quantity of equipment used to fulfill requirements of the resulting contract. Include approximate age or operating cycles.

- 5. A description of the type of equipment and method of OCR (Optical Character Reader), sorting/bar coding used by your company.
- 6. A description of the make and model of your company vehicles.
- 7. A description of the computers your company use for list/label/document processing services.
- 8. A description of the list building and list management capabilities offered including specific demographic, psychographics and geographic criteria available.
- 9. A description of the procedures for and recommended frequency of updates to seven (7) masters lists created and managed for HCC.
- Qualifications and Experience of Firm: This section shall include a description of the firm, including firm's history, size and staff composition. Include a description of the firm's past and current contracts/assignments, which are related to the type of services, required by this solicitation. Describe your company's plan for service recovery strategies to prevent mechanical downtime from affecting client schedules.
- Qualifications and Experience of Personnel: This section shall include a project-staffing plan including resumes for all proposed "key" staff members who will be assigned to this project. An organizational chart, which includes "key" staff members and their respective responsibilities for this project. If personnel substitutions are contemplated on a contingency basis, they should also be identified.
- <u>Small Business Participation</u>: This section shall include a clear statement of the firm's commitment and plan to meet the small business participation goal specified in Paragraph 9, (Instructions to Proposers) of this solicitation.
- <u>Business Data/Financial Statement</u>: This section shall include financial statements (last three years) of the company.
- <u>Price Proposal</u>: The price proposal shall be clearly identified as such in the technical proposal documents. (See Attachment No. 2, Schedule of Items and Prices). Describe the invoicing system used by your company.

5. Evaluation Criteria

An Evaluation Committee ("Committee") will review all proposals to determine which proposers have qualified for consideration according to the criteria stated herein. The committee's evaluations will be based on all available information, including qualification statements, subsequent interviews, if necessary, reports, discussions, reference checks, and other appropriate checks. The highest rated proposers evaluated by the Committee may be invited to make an oral presentation of their written proposal to the Committee and/or the HCC Board of Trustees. Proposals will be evaluated using the following criteria:

6. Contract Award

Award will be made to the responsive, responsible proposer whose proposal conforms to this solicitation and offers the best value to HCC, price and other factors considered. HCC may award a contract, based on initial proposals received, without discussion of such proposals. Accordingly, each initial proposal should be submitted on the most favorable terms from a price and technical standpoint, which the proposer can submit to HCC.

7. Postponement of Proposals Due Date/Time

Notwithstanding the date/time for receipt of proposals established in this solicitation, the date and time established herein for receiving proposals may be postponed solely at HCC's discretion.

8. Oral Presentations

During the process of selecting a company to provide the required services, oral presentations may or may not be held. Each proposer should be prepared to make a presentation to HCC. The presentations must show that the proposer clearly understands the requirements of the solicitation, and has a strategic plan and approach to complete the work.

9. Small Business Development Program (SBDP)

A. HCC has adopted a Small Business Development Program for small businesses attempting to provide goods and/or services as prime contractors or as subcontractors to other prime contractors to HCC. The program is designed to prevent discrimination by ensuring that small, underutilized and disadvantaged businesses are informed and prepared to compete for HCC procurements. HCC will neither discriminate nor select vendors on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, gender, age or disability in its procurement selection process.

- B. Small businesses whose gross annual income averaged over the past three (3) years does not exceed the Small Business Administration's size standard as specified in 13 CFR Part 121 are eligible to apply for participation in the program.
- C. For this solicitation, HCC has established (25%) of the total amount of the proposal as its goal for Small Business participation.
- D. Good Faith Efforts: HCC will make a good faith effort to utilize small businesses in all contracts. The annual program goals may be met by contracting directly with small businesses or indirectly through subcontracting opportunities. Therefore, any business that contracts with HCC will be required to make a good faith effort to award subcontracts to small businesses. The subcontracting goal applies to all vendors regardless of their status By implementing the following procedures, a contractor shall be presumed to have made a good faith effort:
 - To the extent consistent with industry practices, divide the contract work into reasonable lots.
 - Give notice to SBDP eligible firms of subcontract opportunities or post notices of such opportunities in newspapers and other circulars.
 - Document reasons for rejecting a firm that bids on subcontracting opportunities.

10. Small Business Compliance Review

To ensure compliance with the small business participation goal in the resulting contract, the selected contractor will be required to meet with the procurement staff member responsible for this project at the 50% and 75% completion phase to verify small business participation activity.

11. Prime Contractor/Contracts for Services

The selected prime contractor will be required to perform a minimum of 30% of contract services with its labor force and or demonstrate management of the contract for services to the satisfaction of HCC.

12. Internship Program

HCC is expanding its student internship program. All vendors are encouraged to make a commitment to utilize certain HCC student(s) in an internship capacity with the company under any resulting contract for services required under this solicitation. The selected contractor will be expected to pay the student(s) at least the minimum wage required by law. HCC will provide the selected contractor with the name of student(s) eligible to participate in the internship program.

13. Prohibited Communications

Except as provided in exceptions below, the following communications regarding a particular invitation for bids, requests for proposal, requests for qualifications, or other solicitation are prohibited:

[1] Between a potential vendor, service provider, bidder, offeror, lobbyist or consultant and any Trustee;

- [2] Between any Trustee and any member of a selection or evaluation committee; and
- [3] Between any Trustee and administrator or employee.

The communications prohibition shall be imposed on the date that responses to the solicitation are due or received, whichever is first.

The communications prohibition shall terminate when:

- [1] The contract is awarded by the Chancellor or his designee; or
- [2] The award recommendations are considered by the Board at a duly-noticed public meeting.

In the event the Board refers the recommendation back to staff for reconsideration, the communications prohibition shall be re-imposed.

The communications prohibition shall not apply to the following:

- [1] Duly noted pre-bid or pre-proposal conferences.
- [2] Communications with the HCC General Counsel.
- [3] Emergency contracts.
- [4] Presentations made to the Board during any duly noticed public meeting.
- [5] Unless otherwise prohibited in the solicitation documents, any written communications between any parties, provided that the originator shall immediately file a copy of any written communication with the Board Services Office.

The Board Services Office shall make copies available to any person upon request.

[6] Nothing contained herein shall prohibit any person or entity from publicly addressing the Board during any duly-noticed public meeting, in accordance with applicable Board policies, regarding action on the contract.

14. Drug Policy

HCC is a drug-free workforce and workplace. The manufacture, sale, distribution, dispensation, or use of illegal drugs or alcohol by vendors or contractors while on HCC's premises are strictly prohibited.

15. Taxes

HCC is tax exempt as a governmental subdivision of the State of Texas under Section 501C (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Limited Sales Tax Number: 1-74-1709152-1.

16. Explanation to Proposers

Any explanation desired by a prospective proposer regarding the meaning or interpretation of the solicitation documents must be requested in writing and with sufficient time allowed (a minimum of seven (7) calendar days before the date set to receive proposals) for a response to reach prospective proposers before the submission of their proposals. Any HCC response will be in the form of an amendment of the solicitation or an informational letter. The response will be made available to all prospective proposers via HCC website at www.hccs.edu. Receipt of any amendment(s) issued by HCC shall be acknowledged with the proposal submission.

17. Public Information

HCC considers all information, documentation and other materials requested to be submitted in response to this solicitation to be of a non-confidential and/or nonproprietary nature, and therefore, shall be subject to public disclosure under the Texas Public Information Act (Texas Government Code, Chapter 552.001, et seq.) after a contract is awarded.

SCOPE OF SERVICES FOR DATABASE DEVELOPMENT AND MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Scope

This scope of services covers the requirements of the Contractor to provide Database Development & Management Services on an "as needed basis" for Houston Community College System ("HCC").

Summary of Requirements

The Contractor's primary responsibility is to provide list creation and database management to target Houston Community College Service Area markets within the specific demographics that includes Houston ISD, Stafford Municipal School District and Missouri City, as well as portions of Alief, Katy, North Forest and Spring Branch.

Demographic, psychographics, and geographic parameters may include single-family dwellings where head of household earns less than \$50,000 and has some college education, residing within Harris County.

General Requirements

At a minimum, the Contractor shall perform the following:

• Divide service area list into six (6) separate lists for the service areas of five regional and one specialized college. These colleges are:

Central College Northeast College Northwest College Southeast College Southwest College Coleman College

• Update seven (7) lists regularly and make available to designated HCC representatives in the formats of mailing labels, hard copy print-outs, and as excel spreadsheets.

List Creation and Management Specification

At the minimum the Contractor must provide and/or have:

- List Brokering to include:
 - o The type of list research and market research.
 - o Rate cards including usage;
 - O List plan that includes recommendations and quantities;
 - o List clearances for HCC ownership;
 - o Following through on delivery of list to data processing representatives;
 - o and Net name arrangements where applicable.
- Complete Database Management Services that includes the following:
 - o File Processing and Conversion
 - o Formatting
 - o Editing, and
 - o Outputting files.

Contractor shall provide additional up to date postal services to insure maximum deliverability including, but not limited to:

- Coding Accuracy Support System ("CASS") Certification to assign carrier route.
- Presort Accuracy Validation and Evaluation (technical evaluation, US Postal Service) ("PAVE") Certified Software.
- o USPS Postal Numeric Encoding Technique (POSTNET) to bar code ZIP codes, ZIP+4 codes and DPBC (Delivery Point Bar Code).
- o Address Standardizing to correct or filter out bad address records.
- o An "OCR A" (Optical Character Reader Font A) laser font, handwritten fonts and oversized fonts (or comparable).

*Note: Zip code breakdowns are not reflective of service areas, as service area boundaries split numerous zip codes.

Contractor shall provide Merge/Purge Services including:

- Elimination of Duplicates (Dedupe Software to help identify and remove duplicated records from lists, databases, spreadsheets and other sources).
- o Address Clean-up (includes address correction and zip code correction).
- o Procedure to parse outlines of address in preparation for duplicate elimination process.
- o Lists reports and National Changes of Address (NCOA) services.
- Use of multiple suppression files including the Direct Marketing Association's pander file.
- o Data cleansing for deceased file processing.

Records Reconciliation

The Contractor shall meet monthly with the HCC delegated representative to review contract-related data, invoice processing, and revenue figures for the previous month period, and other contract-related issues deemed necessary by HCC and/or the Contractor.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Contract Award

A response to the solicitation is an offer to contract with Houston Community College System ("HCC") based on the terms and conditions contained therein. Proposals do not become contracts until they are accepted by HCC through issuance of written purchase orders or other duly executed documents.

2. Contract Term

The Contract term shall be one (1) year with renewal options of two (2) one-year time periods, unless otherwise extended by HCC in accordance with the terms and conditions of this contract. Any contract renewal or extension may be subject to approval by the Board of Trustees.

3. Interpretation, Jurisdiction and Venue

The Contract shall be construed and interpreted solely in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas. Venue of any suits, right or cause of action arising under or in connection with the contract shall be exclusively in Harris County, Texas.

4. Compliance with Laws

The Contractor shall give all notices and comply with all Federal, State of Texas and local laws. Upon request, the Contractor shall furnish to HCC certificates of compliance with all such laws.

5. Taxes

HCC is tax exempt as a governmental subdivision of the State of Texas under Section 501C (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Limited Sales Tax Number: 1-74-1709152-1.

6. **Termination for Convenience**

HCC may, at its option and discretion, terminate or reduce the scope of services or other requirements of the Contract at any time, without any default on the part of the Contractor, by giving thirty (30) calendar days written notice thereof to the Contractor.

7. **Termination for Default**

HCC may terminate the contract immediately for default, by giving written notice thereof to the Contractor, if the Contractor neglects to execute the work properly; performs in an unsatisfactory manner or fails to perform any provisions of the contract. In the event of termination for default, HCC shall have against the Contractor, all remedies provided by law and equity.

8. **Ethics Conduct**

Any direct or indirect actions taken to unduly influence competitive purposes, to circumvent equal consideration for competitive bidders, or to disregard ethical and legal trade practices will disqualify vendors and contractors from current and future consideration for participation in HCC orders and contracts.

9. Small Business Development Program (SBDP)

The Contractor hereby agrees to attain small business participation in the amount of 25% of the total contract amount.
