Q1. A whole-building Retro-Commissioning approach, particularly with older facilities, typically looks at the building enclosure systems in addition to the MEP systems. RFQ 2.2.8 lists commissioning of the mechanical, electrical, plumbing, fire alarm and building automation/control systems but does not mention building enclosure. Does HCC have an IDIQ contract or a vendor for building enclosure commissioning? If not, to provide a whole building commissioning skill set we propose to add those building enclosure retro-commissioning skills to the submitted team.

Response: HCC currently has a separate IDIQ solicitation related to building envelope, and it will not be a part of this IDIQ.
