


Seniors can take free, discounted classes

Senior citizens who are 65 or older can take classes for up to six credit hours per semester without paying tuition. In addition, normally charged fees for up to six credit hours per semester are also waived.

For those seniors who fall between the ages of 55 to 65, classes can be taken for half off. The discount applies to academic and workforce courses that have not already been filled.

Participants must receive a grade of C or better to continue receiving the discount each

semester. Some courses may have additional specific charges.

"It's bringing hands-on equipment and solutions services for students to learn, practice and get better at cybersecurity," said Samir Saber, dean of DIT.


